Celebrating its 15th Anniversary, Oregon Ballet Theatre welcomes new Artistic Director Christopher Stowell. The season opens with a program called "New Beginnings." Its first work is Balanchine's *Rubies*, a glamorous, athletic and jazzy work for the entire company. Celebrating Stowell's experience with Pacific Northwest Ballet and San Francisco Ballet, the other two major companies on the West Coast, "New Beginnings" also includes *Company B* by Paul Taylor, a major contemporary choreographer with his own New York-based company. With music by the Andrews Sisters, *Company B* demonstrates ballet's compatibility with the jump and jive of popular culture.

Information: Meet outside **the Keller Auditorium** at **10 a.m.** on **Oct. 15**. Look for the **Village Home group sign**.

Parking: On-street metered (few available) or paid parking structure across the street.

Directions:

From I-5 North or I-84 East: Follow I-5 to the City Center/Oregon City Exit. Follow the signs toward City Center. After crossing the Morrison Bridge, follow SW Washington to 3rd Avenue. Turn Left. Go 10 blocks to SW Clay St. Keller Auditorium is the building on the left.

From I-5 South: Follow I-5 to Front Avenue exit. Follow signs to Front avenue. Cross Front Avenue and continue 3 blocks to SW 3rd Avenue. Keller Auditorium is the building on the left.

From Highway 26 West (Sunset): After going through the Vista Ridge Tunnel, get in the center lane. Take the Market St./City Center Exit. Continue on SW Market to 3rd Avenue. Keller Auditorium is the building on the left.

From Highway 26 East (Ross Island Bridge) or Highway 99 East (McLoughlin): After coming off the Ross Island Bridge, follow signs to Highway 26/Front Avenue. Turn right onto Front at the stop signal. At signal, turn left onto SW Clay Street, and continue for 3 blocks to SW 3rd Avenue. Keller Auditorium is the building on the left.
