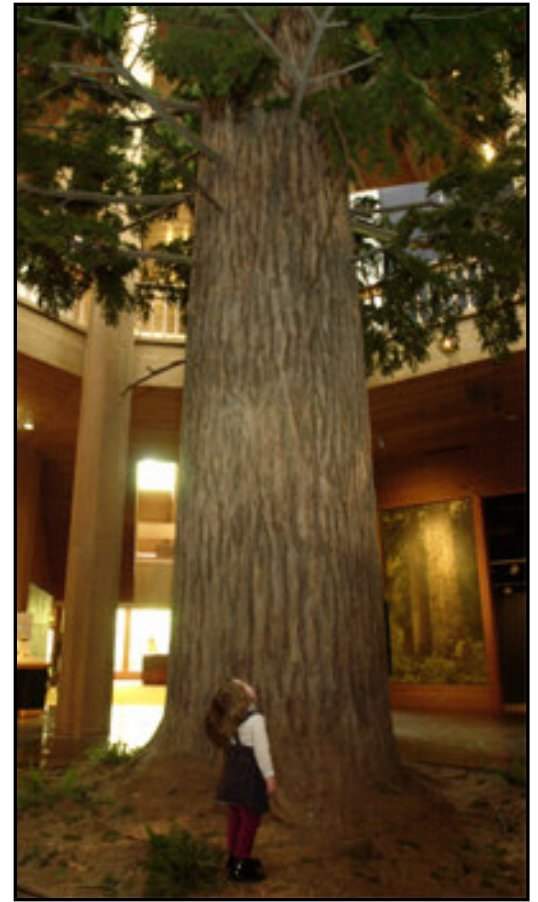

Artfully crafted of native woods, the museum was opened in 1971 by famed Oregon governor Tom McCall. The Forest Discovery Center now features world-class permanent exhibits, educational programs, traveling exhibits and gallery shows, and special community events. It is conveniently located next to the Washington Park MAX light rail station and across from the Children's Museum and the Oregon Zoo.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration: Confirm your pre-registration or sign up on a space-available basis in the Village Home office, on the sign-up sheet for this event. Fill out a permission slip and include it and any fees owing in the Field Trip Registration Envelope.

Your registration is not complete without a permission slip and payment of all fees. Village Home refunds fees only in the event that Village Home cancels an event.

Important Information: Meet at **World Forestry Center** at **1 pm** on **Jan. 9**. Look for **Village Home group sign**. The Field Trip Leader will have tickets and other materials you may need. See the "Bring" list for items you are responsible for bringing.

Parking Information: There is free parking in a large parking field that serves the Oregon Zoo and the Children's Museum. MAX also has a direct stop at this location.

This field trip is an optional add-on to a Clay Workshop at the Children's museum. Register for that workshop separately. You may attend this portion of the trip without going to the Children's Museum first.
