

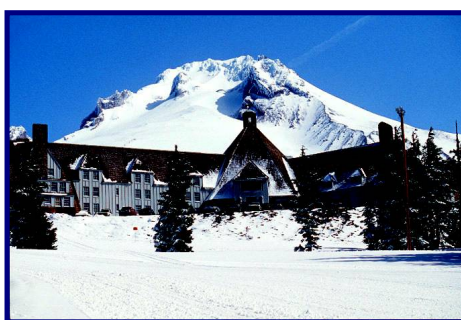

Information: Meet at **the fireplace in the lobby of Timberline Lodge at 10 a.m. on Oct. 24. Look for Village Home group sign.**

Itinerary: **10 am:** meet-up and introduction
10-12: scavenger hunt for kids, followed by outdoor play (hot cocoa optional!)
12-1: lunch (picnic or purchase in main lodge or snack bar). **Optional leave time.**
1-3: short trail hikes
3 pm: Leave for home

- Bring:**
- daypack
 - picnic lunch *or* money to purchase food
 - drinking water
 - trail mix or other snack
 - layered clothing (it can be cold outside but quite warm inside)
 - snow clothes (gloves, hat, boots)
 - camera
 - change of shoes & socks for kids (and adults)
 - hot cocoa in Thermos (optional)
 - spending money (optional)
 - parking money \$3.50
 - notepad & pencil (optional)

Directions:
From Portland: Take I-84 East toward The Dalles. Take Exit 16 "Wood Village." Turn right at stop sign onto 242nd. Follow 242nd to Burnside (approx. 3 mi.). Turn left on Burnside (U-Haul rentals on the corner). Burnside turns into Hwy 26 East at the Newport Bay restaurant. Follow Hwy 26 East to the Timberline Road turn-off (about 40 mi.); pass through the towns of Sandy, Welches, and Rhododendron. Turn left on the Timberline access road; follow the road to Timberline (6 mi.) **Be sure to go to the old historic lodge to meet up, not to the newer day ski lodge.**
